National Survey of Drinking and Driving Attitudes and Behaviors

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration conducts the National Survey of Drinking and Driving Attitudes and Behaviors on a periodic basis to monitor the public's attitudes, knowledge, and self-reported behavior regarding drinking and driving. The 2008 survey was administered by telephone to 6,999 respondents 16 and older. This study is located in the Core Database, document #613220.

Sleep On It

Research has shown that sleep deprivation impairs performance. Lack of adequate sleep contributes to suppression of the immune system, increasing the likeliness of illness. It has also been implicated in weight gain, leading some researchers to conclude that chronic sleep deprivation may be one contributing factor to the obesity epidemic.
